Day 1: Sunday – Indian Pacific, Perth

Day 2: Monday – Indian Pacific, Nullarbor Plain


 Arrive refreshed and eager for a superb sunrise breakfast on the Nullarbor. Back on the train regionally inspired, modern Australian cuisine is on hand, along with fine wines of course for lunch, before alighting the train and

experiencing the extraordinary and ever so slightly eerie, ghost town of Cook. Watch the passing parade of ever-changing landscape over dinner and share stories with old friends and new in the Lounge. (B,L,D)

Day 3: Tuesday – Indian Pacific, Adelaide

 After another comfortable night's sleep, the beautiful but unforgiving scenery is now replaced with softer and more graceful contours as you make your way to Adelaide for a morning arrival. Here you will enjoy an Off Train Excursion. Reboard the Indian Pacific to take in the striking, ever-changing landscape of South Australia as you head east towards Sydney. Over lunch, watch as pastures dissolve into tough Mallee scrub on approach to Broken Hill. Here you will have the opportunity to participate in an Off Train Excursion before re-joining the train for dinner. (B,L,D)

Day 4: Wednesday – Indian Pacific, Sydney

 Wake this morning in readiness to wind your way through the magnificent Blue Mountains where you will disembark the train to explore the highlights of this region before travelling through to Sydney. On arrival make your own way to your accommodation. (B)

Day 5: Thursday – Manly, Bondi and Taronga Zoo

A thorough introduction to Sydney and its neighbours today. Travel to Manly Beach for a leisurely stroll along The Corso to see the beach that has made Manly famous. Along the way to Manly, you will view Darling Harbour and cross the Sydney Harbour Bridge. Stop at Milsons Point for spectacular views of the Sydney Opera House and Harbour Bridge. Stop at North Head Lookout for a panoramic view of the Pacific

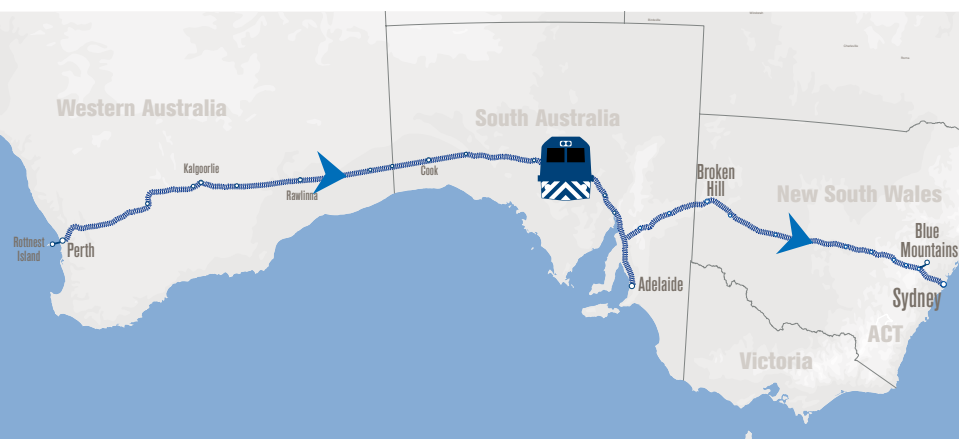
Ocean. Enjoy your time at Manly beach before heading back to Sydney via the exclusive and trendy suburbs of Neutral Bay and Mosman. This afternoon join your cruise to Taronga Zoo. There's always plenty happening with over 4,000 animals to see, over 20 keeper talks and shows a day, your afternoon will be packed full of experiences. (B)

Day 6: Friday – Sydney

Experience Sydney from a local perspective. Explore all the city icons like The Rocks, Sydney Harbour Bridge, and the Sydney Opera House, but explore them in a way most tourists don't. Take the least-walked path on this Sydney walking tour and meander through this fascinating city's tumultuous history and into the modern day. This historic Sydney walk will introduce you to the old and new of Sydney, walk past Cadman's Cottage the oldest building in Australia, under the Harbour Bridge and along the newest development in the City, Barangaroo. Take a stroll down Argyle Place, Nurses Walk and other 'must do' sights such as Customs House and the Sydney Opera House all with your local guide to show you the bits you'd miss on your own!
